## Council News

- Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) in Flintshire .The clerk read out a letter received from Flintshire County Council who is consulting on a proposed Dog Control Public Spaces Protection Order((PSPO) to cover the whole County.They are asking the Community Council to nominate sites by 26 May 2017 to ensure that they are included in the consultation documents. Members requested that the following be named Gwernaffield Playing Fields, The Old School Field Gwernaffield, and The Conservation Garden, Gwernaffield to be considered.
- The clerk reported about the Parking Matters/concerns previously reported at Y Waen with relevant people via letter. Mr A Stanford, Highways Strategy Manager contacted the clerk to advise he will be conducting two surveys in the near future of traffic in Y Waen. They would take place at school dropping off and picking up times after which he would attend a future meeting with findings.
- The annual litter pick in the community took place on 29 April. Once again over 25 bags of rubbish was collected thanks go out to all those that volunteered.
- Councillor C Garrett and Councillor K Williams informed members that they would not be standing for election in May.The Councillors and Clerk thanked them for their commitment to the community council over the years. Both were given small gifts of appreciation.
- ELECTION: Only eight names out of twelve required were put forward for nomination so these were accepted as Councillors. The Council then put out further notices to try to co-opt, fortunately four people put their names forward so we now have a full council. See the back page for a full list and contact details of your Community Councillors.
- The clerk had received an email about a scheme to enable community organisations to acquire their local telephone box for £1.00 as an asset; some community councils have done this. The Community Council asked the Clerk to make further enquiries into this, the clerk asked for the telephone number of the telephone box.
- The Community Council now use the Community Centre at the school every month (with the exception of the August recess) and currently make no financial contribution towards its use. Members considered and discussed this at length. It was proposed by Cllr. R Morgan and seconded by Cllr. A Barsby that a financial contribution of £250.00 per annum be made to the Community Centre.

- Streetscene have asked that if a resident see's a dog fouling the pavement or a public space or footpath then they should report it via Streetscene's page at Flintshire County Council webpage. This is monitored all the time and wardens sent out. Streetscene will also acknowledge your report.
- Flower planters within the community are once again very vibrant and thanks go out to all who sponsor them and the volunteers who look after them. Ysgol Y Waun is to sponsor three planters that have been placed on the Green in Y Waen and by the school sign at the bottom of the footpath. Planters have been made by Cllr Carl Hopwood.

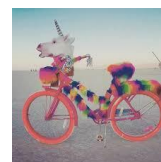
